SAINT PETER

Peter established the believers at Antioch (Syria), where they were called Christians for the first time (Acts 11:26).

This is why our Maronite Patriarch, who is a successor of Saint Peter at the See of Antioch, always takes the name "Peter" as his middle name.



SAINT PAUL

Paul was a Roman citizen, who before his conversion to Christianity was known as Saul. While on his way to Damascus to persecute Christians, he heard the voice of Our Lord: "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?"

He converted to Christianity, was baptized in Damascus and changed his name to Paul. He began his missionary work in Antioch, but also helped spread the faith in Damascus, Syria, Macedonia and Greece.

He wrote his "Epistles" to teach, encourage and discipline the young Christian communities he visited.
