**NEW CARDINALS
OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH**



On Thursday, June 28, Pope Francis created 14 new cardinals and inducted them as members of the College of Cardinals. His Beatitude Louis Raphael Sako, Cardinal of the Chaldean Rite is in his black and red vestments in the photo above.

The new cardinals come from Bolivia, Iraq, Italy, Japan, Pakistan, Poland, Portugal, Peru, Madagascar, Mexico and Spain. The Pope explained that the places from where the new cardinals come “express the universality of the Church” and “manifest the unbreakable bond between the See of Peter and the local Catholic Churches throughout the world”.

Dressed in their red/black robes, the cardinals professed the Creed and then approached Pope Francis one by one, who placed the red biretta (hat) on each one of them and gave them their cardinal’s ring.
