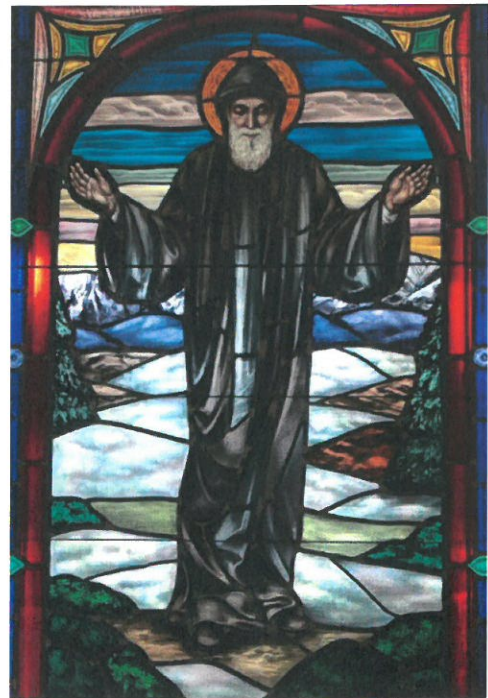

CELEBRATION THIS WEEKEND OF THE FEAST OF SAINT SHARBEL

Saint Sharbel was born Youssef Antoun Makhlof on May 8, 1818, in the village of Bekaa Kafra, in the mountains of Lebanon. In 1851 he entered religious life in a Maronite Lebanese Order, changing his name to Sharbel, who was a martyr of the early church.

Father Sharbel spent the last 23 years of his life at the Hermitage of Saints Peter and Paul, living as a solitary hermit. He died on Christmas Eve in 1898, and is buried at the monastery of Saint Maron Annaya.

This monastery, relatively unknown in the past, has become a beacon of religious attraction. Pilgrims from all over the world and from different religious denominations started coming to seek the intercession of Saint Sharbel, after it was reported that favors and extraordinary cures were attributed to him. He was canonized on October 9, 1977, by Pope Paul VI.
