On another note, please keep Deacon John Jarvis in your prayers. He is currently in the hospital and we hope and pray for a speedy recovery.

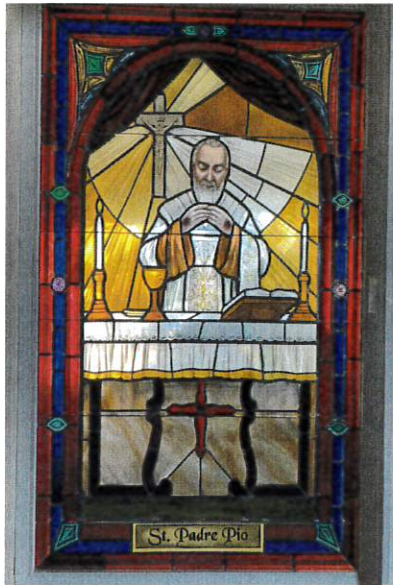

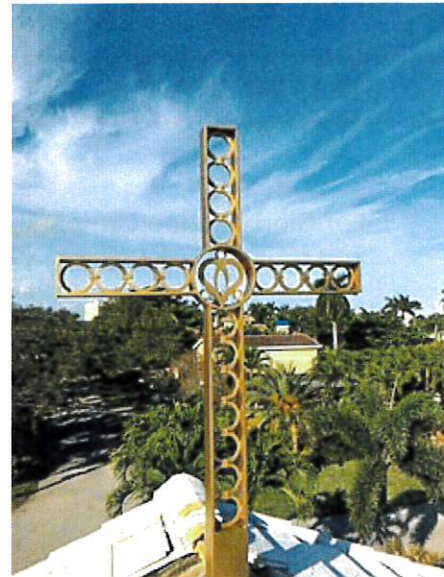
