NOW ACCEPTING DONATED ITEMS

You are welcome to bring your items to the hall starting **Sunday October 20, after Mass**. You can also bring items to the hall **Monday – Friday, from 9:00 am – 3:30 pm** (note that we close the hall at 4:00 pm sharp). When you bring your items to the hall.

Electronics: Please be sure that you include any **power cords** that are required and attach them to the item; (do not worry about batteries which we can provide); If your item requires a **disk** to make it work (such as a printer), please provide the disk.

Tools: Be sure they are clean (i.e., no grease or severe rust)

Appliances: Please be sure that you include any **power cords** that are required by the item. Old appliances must work. If they are broken, please do not bring them. It would be appreciated if the item was **clean** from kitchen grease.

Clothing, Bedding, & Rugs: Used clothes are not our best sellers, but we do accept them. Please be sure that they are not filthy or torn. Pillows, sheets and blankets also sell if they are not torn or stained. We accept small area rugs as well.

Jewelry: These are good sellers but, do not expect gold jewelry to be sold at gold prices – remember, this is a flea market, we take whatever is our best offer (usually well below what an item is worth).

Art, Posters, Frames, & Mirrors: We accept these as well.

Household: Sometimes dishes and glasses sell well and sometimes they do not, but we certainly accept them. Sets of fine China and crystal will be sold with ordinary dinnerware, as most people are not interested in quality items these days. We accept **clean** pots and pans as well.

Toys: Must be in working condition.


Seasonal decorations: Christmas and other seasonal decorations items sell if they are not broken.

WHO ARE THE MARONITES?

The Maronite Church is one of 22 Eastern Rites of the Catholic Church, under the authority of the Pope. It dates back to the early Christians of Antioch (Syria) where Jesus' followers "were called Christians for the first time" (Acts II:26). The actual name "Maronite" is derived from the name of Saint Maron, who was a priest and hermit, and died around the year 410 AD.

As part of the Roman Catholic Church, Maronites profess the beliefs in same the Dogmatic and Moral teachings of the Church and celebrate the same seven Sacraments. Their liturgical celebrations are more unique and reflect their early Apostolic beginnings. For example, in some prayers and hymns of the Mass, the Maronites still use Syriac, a dialect of the Aramaic language spoken by Jesus and his Apostles, and incense is regularly used.

During the civil and religious persecutions of the 7th century, the Maronites fled their churches and monasteries in the plains of Syria, and took refuge in the verdant mountains and caves of nearby Lebanon. Since then, Lebanon has been considered the homeland of the Maronite Church.

Millions of Maronites now live in various countries throughout the world, but their Mother Church remains in Lebanon. The current Maronite Patriarch, Bechara Peter Rai, was made a Cardinal by Pope Benedict XVI, in November of 2012. Cardinal Rai lives at the Maronite Patriarchal residence in Bkerke, Lebanon.

The United States is home to two Maronite Eparchies (Dioceses). The Most Reverend Gregory Mansour is our Bishop who resides in Brooklyn, New York. Bishop Mansour is a member of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), as is the Maronite Bishop of the Western Eparchy, the Most Reverend Elias Zaidan who resides in Los Angeles.
